ReNew Life Ministry

ReNew is the support & recovery ministry of Oak Pointe Church, offering new, confidential groups beginning September 20th. Groups meet every Monday evening from 7:00-9:00 p.m. Call Debra Carwile at 248.912.0043, x379 to register now, or register online starting in August.

- **Boundaries:** If you struggle to say "no," and too often say "yes," this group is for you. Perfect for parents or partners who struggle with taking healthy control.
- **Before You Divorce:** If you're on the brink of divorce and feel like your marriage is beyond hope, we STRONGLY encourage you to check out this group. You'll get a realistic understanding of the impact that divorce will have on your family, and learn a Christ-centered, biblical strategy for stopping divorce.
- **DivorceCare:** A group for men & women experiencing separation or going through divorce, or who are divorced. Find the support and encouragement you need to heal and move forward with your life.
- **GriefShare:** A support group for men & women who are grieving the death of a loved one. GriefShare will help you face your challenges and help you move toward rebuilding your life.
- **Healing is a Choice:** Everyone needs healing on some level, and this popular group explores the 10 crucial choices you make when you're ready to heal. Learn to challenge the lies that have held you back from experiencing life in a new way.
- **Letting Go of Anger:** Anger robs you of precious energy and relationships. Understand the 11 most common styles of anger and what to do about them.
- **Men's Integrity:** A support group for men seeking recovery from lust, pornography, sexually addictive behaviors, and/or difficult relationships affected by issues of sexual integrity.
- **Cross Current:** A Christ-centered group for men who experience unwanted same-sex attraction. Find support and a safe environment in which to heal.
- **DivorceCare for Kids:** Equips elementary aged children to move forward with life after divorce or separation.
- **YourSpace:** A drop-in support group for teens who need to talk about what's going on in their lives. Discussions are guided and Christ-centered.
